 Students must have a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA.  
 Students must have completed 30 semester hours of academic credit.  
 Prerequisite courses must be completed prior to admission.  
 POLS 3200 requires a minimum grade of "C".

**\*Multidisciplinary Menu:**  
 POLS 3200 only has to be completed once for program requirements.  
 Students must complete four courses from an approved menu of courses dealing substantially with the EU. These courses must be distributed among at least three different discipline areas: Social Sciences, Humanities and Fine Arts, Business and Economics, and Natural and Health Sciences. The program's campus representative decides which courses qualify for the certificate and maintains an updated list of approved courses in the different discipline areas.  
 No more than one course can be taken at the 1000-2000 level, with the exception of the EU Studies online courses and study abroad.  
 Students may substitute for up to two menu courses by performing an internship and/or composing a thesis.
